A: KIDSTOP

Q: This program matches at-risk youth with a caring adult volunteer role model, through community-based mentoring. Serves youth ages 7-14.

A: LSS Community Mentoring

Q: This program provides for needs victims have outside of counseling. Includes resource referrals, safety planning, navigating court system, protection order assistance, and attending hearings.

A: The Compass Center : Victim Advocacy

Q: This program provides abused and neglected children with a volunteer advocate, who serves on the child's behalf through the overburdened juvenile court system.

A: Sioux Falls Area CASA Program

Q: This program empowers adults and children to thrive through literacy education.

A: REACH Literacy

Q: This program provides no-cost rides to various medical appointments for seniors and financially limited people.

A: Project CAR

Q: This program is dedicated removing the stigma of substance use disorder through awareness, education, and prevention; and removing financial barriers for treatment and recovery.
