**1 care giver** of adult loved ones was provided with assistance, education, and support through Active Generations' CAREgivers program.

**13 older adults** were provided nutritional meals in their homes or in a congregate dining setting, allowing them to maintain a healthy and independent lifestyle through Active Generations' Meals on Wheels program.

**3 new parents** received resource booklets, temperament assessments and other resources through Avera McKennan's Success by 6 program.

**1 domestic violence victim** was provided with immediate information and support through Children's Home Shelter for Family Safety's Crisis Intervention.

**1 victim of domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, human trafficking, and child abuse/neglect** was provided safe shelter at Children's Home Shelter for Family Safety when fleeing from a domestic abuse situation.

**5 people** received counseling through Family Service.

**22 individuals** received referral information through the Helpline Center's 211.

**5 people** were connected to the appropriate resources via a shared network to coordinate basic needs services through Helpline Center's Network of Care.

**3 individuals** received information and referrals to volunteer opportunities through Helpline Center.

**2 individuals and families** participated in therapy and counseling services through Lutheran Social Services.

**1 adult** who had committed domestic violence received structured therapy groups to teach safe and healthy relationship skills to help prevent further intimate partner violence through Lutheran Social Services' Family Violence Project.

**2 families** with children who were victims of abuse or sexual assault were provided with counseling and support through Sanford Health's Child's Voice Family Advocate.

**12 new parents** received information about their child's development and temperament through Sanford Children's Success by 6 program.

**3 boys** participated in Boy Scouts.

**37 children** received books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program that provides the opportunity for children 5 years of age and under to receive a free book each month.

**1 adult or child** who was a victim of sexual assault or domestic violence received support services through The Compass Center.
