6 new parents received resource booklets, temperament assessments and other resources through Avera McKennan's Success by 6 program.

2 youths received quality childcare and educational programs through Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sioux Empire's Early Childhood Education.

1 first-time expectant mother with limited resources received home visits from nurses during pregnancy and after delivery through Children's Home Shelter for Family Safety's BrightStart Program.

1 domestic violence victim was provided with immediate information and support through Children's Home Shelter for Family Safety's Crisis Intervention.

1 person received counseling through Family Service.

2 families received furniture through the Furniture Mission.

2 individuals with disabilities received therapeutic horseback riding, hippotherapy, or other services through HorsePower.

25 individuals received referral information through the Helpline Center's 211.

2 people were connected to the appropriate resources via a shared network to coordinate basic needs services through Helpline Center's Network of Care.

2 individuals utilized a 24 hour hotline during a crisis or participated in suicide trainings or support groups through Helpline Center's Suicide & Crisis Support.

2 individuals received information and referrals to volunteer opportunities through Helpline Center.

2 individuals and families participated in therapy and counseling services through Lutheran Social Services.

3 families with children who were victims of abuse or sexual assault were provided with counseling and support through Sanford Health's Child's Voice Family Advocate.

3 new parents received information about their child's development and temperament through Sanford Children's Success by 6 program.

28 boys participated in Boy Scouts.

45 children received books from Dolly Parton's Imagination Library, a program that provides the opportunity for children 5 years of age and under to receive a free book each month.
